

WISBOROUGH GREEN PARISH COUNCIL FILMING POLICY

Wisborough Green is a quintessential English village, with a village green, public houses, pond, Church, village shop and Post Office in the centre of the village. As such, the Parish Council is sometimes approached by film companies for permission to film in the village centre.

The Parish Council acknowledges that the picturesque and historical character of the village centre is appealing to those in the film industry and in order to promote the village and support the local economy, the Parish Council will support the use of Parish Council land for filming purposes, provided that:

- The proposed date and time does not conflict or interfere with any other events or sports fixtures being held on the village green.
- A 'Use of the Green' Agreement Form to be completed and returned with a copy of the Public Liability Insurance certificate and Risk Assessment.
- Vehicles are not to be parked on the village green – the Village Hall car park to be used for auxiliary vehicles not required for filming to avoid congestion on the village roads.
- The proposed filming is not promoted to attract additional members of the public without traffic management measures in place.
- A suggested fee as a donation towards the upkeep of the village toilets as follows:
 - Educational Programmes £100 flat fee
 - TV Shows, Dramas £100 per hour (£100 minimum)
 - Feature Films £1000 per day
