6. Land South Of Meadowbank: KC confirmed that following the Parish Council meeting, the submission for the Reserve Matters Application had been circulated and approved prior to submission to Chichester District Council (CDC). A Petworth Road resident had contacted the Clerk to again stress her concern at traffic speed and pedestrian access, highlighting that the speed and volume of traffic, in her opinion, had increased since the 2014 application traffic survey. She had spoken with District Councillor, Josef Ransley, who advised that a further survey could be undertaken. Members agreed that the principle of the site development had been established but highlighting these concerns to West Sussex Highways might help to obtain developer funding for improvements, particularly for the pavement surface. Members agreed that the Clerk to write to WS Highways.

7. New Pavilion Plans: In order to complete the annual Community Infrastructure Audit for CDC, the Parish Council had received an update from the Sports Association; plans were progressing. Members agreed that early community consultation was important and as such, the Parish Council would help to facilitate prior to submission of the planning application to CDC. It was agreed that Parish Council members should meet with Sports Association project members to discuss further. Date to be arranged.
